Did you Know:

Many landowners are concerned that their land will not receive adequate care due to the lack of interest from the younger generation

Some current landowners have concerns with handing land over to family members with substance abuse or other problems

Some landowners face the inability or unwillingness to deal with the reality that their land will someday be owned by the next generation

40% of forest landowners don't have a written will or other estate planning preparations
